[Damon Runyon Broadway tickets](#), prices vary

My Fair Lady! Dear Evan Hansen! Aladdin! Hamilton! Get the best seats to nearly every show on Broadway and support cancer research at the same time. Tickets go on sale on the first business day of each month for performances taking place the following month. The ticket price is typically twice the box office price, half of which is a tax-deductible donation to the Damon Runyon Cancer Research Foundation. Since 1946, promising scientists identified and supported by Damon Runyon have made breakthrough discoveries that have transformed our understanding of cancer and developed new approaches to prevention, diagnosis and treatment.

Tony Bennett is not only a multiple Grammy- and Emmy-winning musician—he’s also an accomplished painter. For the past 25 years, he has designed holiday cards to benefit the American Cancer Society and raised more than \$800,000 for the organization. This year’s limited-edition assortment pack features 24 designs from over the years and includes two of the brand-new “Snowstorm in NYC” card. (The city just had one!)

The Pink Pony Fund is Ralph Lauren’s global initiative in the fight against cancer. Originally launched to battle breast cancer, the fund has since expanded its mission to reduce disparities in care across a wide range of cancers. All of the proceeds from the sale of each “Live Love” T-shirt

will be donated to the Pink Pony Fund, which provides grants to cancer centers and research organizations, including Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, the Breast Cancer Research Foundation, the University of Chicago Cancer Research Foundation, the Martin Luther King Jr., Outpatient Center and the Ralph Lauren Center for Cancer Care.

After being diagnosed with childhood cancer at age 4, Alex Scott decided to set up a lemonade stand to raise money for a cure. Sadly, Alex passed away in 2004, but the following year, her parents started the Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation (ALSF) to continue the work that she began. It features over 55 recipes from world-renowned chefs, influential mixologists, celebrities and supporters—and it even includes kid-friendly recipes for little ones to follow. One hundred percent of the proceeds benefit ALSF.
